




Is your life better, the same as or worse than 5 years ago?





Do you think life 5 years from now will be better, the same or worse than today?








Since 1994, have relations between people of different races in South Africa improved, stayed the same or become worse?






Have you personally experienced any form of racism in the past five years?












Do the different races need each other for progress and should there be full opportunity for all?








Do you believe that South African sports teams should be selected only on merit and ability and not by racial quotas?








At school, would you prefer for your child to be taught by...?










What impact does illegal immigration have on SA's unemployment numbers?






Do you prefer a political party which promises faster economic growth and more jobs or one which promises land expropriation without compensation as redress for past wrongs?



Will better education and more jobs decrease inequality within South Africa?






What should the top two priorities of the government be?










What are the chances of you voting in the 2024 general elections?






Will the 2024 national elections be free and fair?






Reasons for not voting in the 2024 general elections





What reaction are you anticipating from the ANC, should they lose the 2024 election?








Leaders' unfavourability





If the general election was today, who would you vote for?






How the ANC's 2024 performance is likely to set the political course following 2024 NPE
