# Tourism numbers show impact of Covid

Tourism is an important contributor to the South African economy. Before the Covid-19 pandemic it contributed about 3% to the country's GDP. This was a bigger contribution than that of agriculture.

At the same time, about 4% of South Africans worked in the tourism sector. The number of South Africans working in tourism – before the Covid-19 pandemic – was higher than the number of people involved in the mining industry.

However, as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic, the related lockdowns, and disruptions (both locally and internationally) saw a major decline in tourism.

This edition of *Free*FACTS looks at recent trends with regard to foreign tourism in South Africa. It shows that while there has been a slight recovery in 2021 and 2022 foreign tourism numbers are still far below what they were before the pandemic.

Tourism numbers in the first three months of this year are far above what they were in the corresponding period last year. However, if we compare them with the same period in 2019 and 2020 there has been a significant drop.

For example, in January of this year, nearly 400 000 foreigners visited South Africa, nearly three times the number that visited in January 2021. But this is a significant decline compared to 2019 and 2020. In January of 2019 over 1-million people from abroad visited South Africa, a similar number as the same month in 2020.

As the Covid-19 pandemic becomes a memory South Africa must work hard to get tourism numbers back to where they were and improve them. Thought must be given to allowing more countries visa-free access to South Africa, and ensuring that major tourist attractions, such as the Kruger National Park, are well maintained and world class.

Tourism is an important area for South African development. It is a sector which can employ large number of unskilled people. In addition, tourism and jobs related to it can act as an important economic multiplier, creating a virtuous circle of economic activity and development.
